

For the interior: after using the diffuser once, if the same fragrance is placed in the diffuser, there is no need to clean its interior

If you change fragrance, follow these steps to clean it beforehand:

1-Fill the diffuser with warm water (not hot water as it may crack the glass)

2-Let it soak and, if needed, use the small brush to rub the interior

3-When water is back to room temperature, empty the diffuser

4-Fill in the diffuser with rubbing alcohol and let it soak (if needed, use the small brush to rub)

5-Empty the diffuser and rinse it few times with warm water

6-With the pipette, extract any water remaining in the diffuser

7-Let diffuser air dry before adding a new essential oil inside

*If the interior of the diffuser is sticky, it is possible to add 1 drop of dishwashing liquid with the warm water (step 1) and to rub with the small brush. However, several rinses will be needed alternating with warm water and rubbing alcohol (steps 1-2-3-4-5) to ensure all soap residues have been removed
